

STORM SUMMARY 1-14-2025

A short period of light snow and snow showers moved through the area mainly between 4am to 8:30am. This was a very fluffy snow. The liquid equivalent in many areas was around t-.02 while snow amounts ranged from a dusting to an inch mainly from around I88 north and up to a couple of inches further south. Salt residue from the previous helped control some of the accumulation on pavement but crews still needed to do some work such as apply additional salt and in some areas push the snow. Officially O'Hare had .7 snowfall, Midway .2, Romeoville 1.8 and Rockford .3
