For the first snow of the season, a powerful storm system developed over the Great Lakes and Upper Midwest and brought a strong cold front with snowshowers and high winds Wednesday afternoon and evening. Some of these snowshowers brought brief periods of heavy snow to some areas as temperatures fell into the low 30s and upper 20s. Light snow showers and flurries continued into early Thursday. Then a heavier area of snow spread into Illinois from Wisconsin that brought periods of moderate to heavy snow throughout Thursday morning before changing to rain Thursday afternoon. Snowfall ranged from 2 to 5 inches in many locations north of I-90 and east of I-355. Amounts were less than 1 inch in the far west towards Rockford. Amounts were less on warmer pavements. Temperatures rose into the low 40s Thursday evening. Meteorologist: Tom Piazza, CCM
